3 CASE STUDY

Scheme Description: Addiscombe Railway Park, Addiscombe

Croydon Council Environmental Cultural & Sports Services acquired a stretch of land which was originally a railway line, and converted it to what is now the Addiscombe Railway Park.

Brief

- * Collect two old railway platform benches from a Croydon Council depot, refurbish and install.
- * Make out of reclaimed railway sleepers, waymarker posts with signage, for a shared footpath/cycle way.
- * Make out of reclaimed railway sleepers, a set of posts identifying the new Addiscombe Railway Park.
- * To maintain a link with the past usage of the land as a railway line, to collect railway memorabilia dumped on the site, refurbish, and create a display.

Materials used:

% Recycled content

* Main Waymarker - Posts - Reclaimed Timber	100%
* Steel Bench - saved from a previous Croydon Park location, refurbished and reinstalled	100%
* Points Box - dumped on site when railway line demolished, refurbished and displayed	100%
* Shared Cycle/Pedestrian waymarker post - reclaimed timber	98%
* Signage	2%
* Sleepers - second hand railway sleepers	100%
* Steel - dumped on site - cut to size and used for the display	100%
* Granite chips - dumped on site - gathered for the display	100%
* Display edging - recycled plastic	100%
